Performance notes

This score is conceived as a theatre play.

It is composed in the context of a project around text and music, in collaboration with ensemble Lipparella and director Karl Dunér.

The score is based on the poem *Thema und variation* by Austrian writer Ingeborg Bachmann, from the collection *Die gestundete Zeit* (1953).

Details such as timbre, articulation, dynamics and tempo are not written out, but decided upon by the performers as part of the interpretation process.

The director is responsible for the staging and the overall direction, which may imply a re-interpretation of the score and the musical decisions made by the performers.

Some of the movements have a timeless and ambient character, and could be conceived as a very early music or perhaps a music from the future.

Other movements sound old in the sense that they allude to a musical language that until very recently was conceived as being new and modern.

Yet another type of movement is conceived as a kind of musical game.

These aspects of the music are all related to the context of the poetry of Ingeborg Bachmann.






